FALL PROGRAM—

October 2017 through April 2018

Grades 1-5

Our Fall program begins in October, 2017 and classes are held in our Youth Center. Classes are 1 hour and 15 minutes long and meet 21 times during the school year.

These classes fill up on a first come-first served basis and are subject to catechist availability. If you are interested in sharing your faith with a group of children, either your own child or at another grade level, please give us a call.

The Home Study Program is a great option for families who have a busy schedule and are better served by the flexibility of this program. By registering for the Home Study program, you will become your child's catechist using the materials provided by St. Michael FLT. There will be two **mandatory** informational meetings (one in the summer for families who would like to get a jump start on the program and one in the Fall). You can choose either meeting (you will receive a postcard reminder) for you and your child. At this meeting, you will receive a student workbook, parent guide, service project information, and important dates. Registration for Home Study is the same as for a class—use the registration form enclosed and check Home Study.

Grades 6 and 7

Students who will be in grades 6 or 7 in the Fall have the option to attend our Fall FLT classes which are held on Monday evenings at 6pm, Home Study, or the 2017 Summer FLT Program.

The traditional Fall program runs from October through April and meets from 6pm until 7:15pm 21 times during the school year in our Youth Center.

The Home Study program is a great option for families who have a busy schedule and are better served by the flexibility of this program. There will be two **mandatory** informational meetings (one in the summer for families who would like to get a jump start on the program and one in the Fall). You can choose either meeting (you will receive a postcard reminder) for you and your child. At this meeting, you will receive a student workbook, parent guide, service project information, and important dates.

Registration for Home Study is the same as for a class—use the registration form enclosed and check Home Study.

The Summer FLT program is for students who are registered members of St. Michael on February 1, 2017. Registration forms were mailed home separately. *Deadline to register for the Summer program is April 15.*

How does E-Giving Work?

This secure program works directly with your credit

union or bank, in the same way as other electronic payments you may already make (such as utility bills or your mortgage payment). All transactions are done electronically, debiting your account automatically for the amount you wish to give. It is a hassle-free, simple solution that will make your life easier!

How do I sign up?

You can visit the St. Michael website at www.stmichaelcc.org and click on the E-Giving link. The link will take you to the secure site that manages the donation. Once you are at the site, you will be asked to register as a new user. You will be setting up a user name and password that is only yours. You will need to provide your envelope number (this number can be found on your Sunday envelopes, on your pre-printed FLT registration form to the left of your family name, or call the FLT Office at 566-4491 and we can look it up), bank routing number, and checking account number if you will be donating through your bank account.

Once you are registered, you will specify the amount of your donation, the frequency (one-time, weekly, monthly, etc.), and the specific donation/payment type (Religious Education Tuition payment). In addition, once you have set up your account information, you can use this service to make Sunday, CSA, CLT, or holy day donations as well. ***This link is completely secure.***

3. Bill Pay

You can use your banks' on-line bill payment system to make one or more payments to St. Michael Catholic Community like you would your electric or gas bill. Just use St. Michael Catholic Community FLT as the "Pay to" name and your envelope number as the account number.
