# Council Chairperson's Report / Parishioners Viewpoint - Virginia

- No VMEs or other input was received.
- Brought up the PC meeting schedule for 2012-2013 specifically related to meetings in March (near Easter) and at the end of the year. The PC discussed the topic, but agreed not to make any changes. The schedule will be reviewed again next year.

### **Old Business**

- Worship Commission Objectives Laurie
  - Emphasis was on participation, evangelization, and education.

- The objectives were well received and Council commented positively on depth / structure of the initiative.
- Education Commission Objectives Laurie
  - Again a very thorough review
  - Laurie discussed a Formation Workshop on Evangelization next September for the PC, Commissions, Catechists, and other members of the Parish community.
     It is likely to take place on September 18 and displace all, or a large part of the PC Meeting.
- Several other topics related to goals and objectives were discussed.
  - The first was simply a reiteration of how important it will be to assign the individual objectives to multiple people (delegate) to enhance participation and the ability to accomplish.
  - Secondly, we agreed that the objectives and progress should be reviewed by each of the Commissions twice per year with the Parish Council. Initial thoughts were to have the first set of reviews in November 2012, and the second set in the April/May 2013 time frame.
  - Third, Virginia covered some of the revised goals from Christian Service and agreed to send out a copy to the Council in the standard format.

  - Kim Kook will be the Secretary
- Administrative tasks for 2012-2013 Keith
