• NEW FLT POLICY

Beginning in the summer of 2020, Confirmation formation will be a 3 year program that will begin in Grade 6 and culminate with the reception of Confirmation in Grade 8.

Students entering 2nd (First Reconciliation/Communion) and 8th (Confirmation) grades must have attended FLT classes for the years prior to receiving their sacraments. Students will be placed in a grade according to the level needed for proper formation.

FALL PROGRAM— September 2019 through April 2020 (schedule TBD) *Grades 1-5*

Our Fall program begins in September, 2019 and classes are held in our Youth Center. Classes are 1 hour and 15 minutes long.

These classes fill up on a first come-first served basis and are subject to catechist availability. If you are interested in sharing your faith with a group of children, either your own child or at another grade level, please give us a call.

The Home Study Program is a great option for families who have a busy schedule and are better served by the flexibility of this program. By registering for the Home Study program, you will become your child's catechist using the materials provided by St. Michael FLT. Home Study books will be made available in May if you would like to get a jump on the program over the summer. You will receive a student workbook, parent guide, and important dates. Registration for Home Study is the same as for a class—use the registration form enclosed and check Home Study.

How do I sign up?

You can visit the St. Michael website at www.stmichaelcc.org and click on Donate Now (E-Giving). The link will take you to the Simply Said secure site that manages the donation. Once you are at the site, you will be asked to register as a new user. You will be setting up a user name and password that is only yours. You will need to provide your envelope number (this number can be found on your Sunday envelopes or call the Parish Office at 586-247-0020 for assistance), bank routing number, and checking account number if you will be donating through your bank account.

Once you are registered, you will specify the amount of your donation, the frequency (one-time, weekly, monthly, etc.), and the specific donation/payment type (Religious Education Tuition payment). In addition, once you have set up your account information, you can use this service to make Sunday, CSA, or holy day donations as well. *This link is completely secure.*

3. Bill Pay

You can use your banks' on-line bill payment system to make one or more payments to St. Michael Catholic Community like you would your electric or gas bill. Just use St. Michael Catholic Community FLT as the "Pay to" name and your envelope number as the account number.
