Enrichment – Reflection and discussion of 3/8 mass readings

- <u>First Reading (First Genesis 12:1-4A)</u>: amazed by the commitment of Abram to follow God's command; context of Abram story (he was so comfortable in his life, and yet he followed God's call without knowing what was in front of him); one of the earliest covenants (before Adam and Moses, after Noah); historical time frame (time between Abram and Moses-hard to measure, but many, many generations); story of Joseph (sold into slavery in Egypt)
- <u>Second Reading (Second Timothy 1:8B-10)</u>: challenge of being called to a holy life by God's design (hard to see God's plan in our suffering and struggles); challenge of understanding God's plan before time began (understanding the vastness of it)
- Gospel Reading (Matthew 17:1-9): Peter, James, and John have a religious experience that they can't quite communicate it; Peter's first inclination is to build something
