Pastoral Team Report

<u>Fr. Mike</u>-Renovations of Father Tim's condo will wrap up this week; thanks to Knights of Columbus, Dave Kotal and Tom O'Grady for their assistance in front office renovation and everyone's patience during the process; social hall will be updated in the future

Deacon Franz-Advent books for parishioners (book for families, book on hope, book for kids); 11/3 Memorial Mass volunteer slots are filled; desire of worship commission to focus programming on young people and families (success of Trunk or Treat shows this is possible); ideas include: prayer and worship services during Lent after Road to Emmaus programming; continuation of kids' Thanksgiving mass; possibility of having kids help in decorating church for special masses (with Tom); teen masses; Parish Council has a responsibility to help focus Father Mike's pastoral vision by working with/encouraging other parish organizations; would like to see all parish organizations work on programming for youth; discussion of advertising for Thanksgiving Mass at next year's Trunk or Treat; grandparents as an important vehicle for youth programming (many grandparents drive children and help family values towards church); calls on all PC members to think about young people/family programming ideas; Deacon is stepping down as Chair of Worship Commission after 4 years; Father Mike will appoint someone in the near future; AOD is going to require parishes to put together liturgy planning teams to write Commentaries and Prayers of Faithful, which will put "new blood" into the process; useful to have someone with new ideas to take Worship Commission over; Worship Commission now has 12 members (had 3 members when Deacon started as Chair)

Commission Reports

- Stewardship: No report
- Worship: Deacon Franz stepping down, will stay through Easter to advise, many accomplishments under his guidance. He gave the information during his report time.

- Christian Service: Gleaners phone number needs to be available; Krafty Korner is November 16th and 17th; Christian Service Cookbook is available for \$5.00 (proceeds will go to Ladder Fund); Christian Service members are meeting once a month to sew heart pillows and tote bags for SKIP (Supporting Kids in Pain); representatives of the commission will be volunteering at the Parish Memorial Mass; currently work is being done on tags for Giving Tree; Mercy in Action Day follow-up (people worked at the Carmelite motherhouse, cutting brush and sprucing the place up); members are also making mats and packing bags for the homeless)
- Christian Education: Sacred Parenting is continuing into early November (40 people involved with program); working on planning for Children's Liturgy; 2 new catechists in the program; planning on a parish Advent Prayer Clock
- Evangelization: Trunk or Treat was a success (612 kids participated; lots of positive comments); would like to include literature on Thanksgiving Liturgy at next year's event; proposed ideas for future events (Valentine's Day Dance, Christmas play, teen-dedicated Mass)
- Youth Representative: Halloween-themed cruise was done with other teen groups (8 kids participated from St. Michael); Pointsettia sale coming up in December; 60 boxes of food will be packed as part of the Thanksgiving Food Drive; Confirmation is November 5th and members of the Youth Group will be participating in the mass; Elizabeth shared the plastic mat project that she has been participating in (hope is that we can collect bags for this project and work with youth group in January)
- Vicariate Representative Report: Coffee and Donuts November 17 with Krafty Korner; Dr. Dan Gerlach, speaker from Sacred Heart Seminary, discussed the seminary; **Adventures in Discipleship** shows how we can be more like the disciples; each parish is to have their own plan for "Unleashing the Gospel"; Trunk or Treat info shared; discussion of " how do you approach the sadness of closing a parish"; Need to find a way to brainstorm online; November 11th is next meeting
