Pastoral Team Reports

<u>Fr. Mike</u>: Pastoral team will be meeting in the next couple weeks; Thursday evening mass has been temporarily halted as we work through reopening of church; 9:30 weekday masses continue-about 10 people for weekday masses

<u>Deacon Franz</u>: Attendance at last week's masses-40 parishioners at 4:30, 38 parishioners at 8:00, 28 parishioners at 9:45, 18 parishioners at 11:30 mass; working out the logistics of the mass and sanitization before and after masses; hoping for a moderate increase in attendance over time so we can continue to tweak the system; hoping to have an outdoor mass later this summer

Old Business

Parish Council Representatives for 2021: Meghan has declined option to stay on an additional year;
Carol and Julie are willing to stay on an additional year, if necessary; discussion about whether bylaws have to be changed if PC members extend their terms (Father Mike has authority to extend terms without changing the bylaws); we'll talk about this again once nominations come in, based on whether we need Parish Council representatives

Commission Reports (reports only given if there are updates)

- <u>Christian Service</u>: report sent out to Parish Council prior to meeting; Knights of Columbus proud to give \$2000 scholarships to two high school seniors in the parish (Natalie Harris and Jonathan Wilk); virtual cereal drive 5/18-6/8 (childrensdmc.org/cerealdrive); virtual 5K on 8/29 for Families Against Narcotics
- <u>Evangelization</u>: new AOD initiative (grouping 3-5 parishes to free up pastors' time to pursue spiritual work)-trying to address the priest shortage and need to share parish resources; details of the plan are still not fully released (there are a lot of questions); concern about how this will be enacted and the practical effectiveness of plan; missionary strategic plan is on hold until parishes are formed into families (of 3-5 parishes) because the families of parishes will make decisions about the strategic plan
- Youth Representative: virtual youth meetings (5/8 was a photo scavenger hunt; 5/22 was a trivia game)

New Business

- New Vice-Chair and Secretary:
 - Review of duties (Vice Chair transitions to Chairperson in third year; Chair prepares meetings, helps communicate with members of Parish Council, handles nominations for Parish Council)
 - Nominee for Vice Chair: Dillon (nominated by Deacon Franz); accepted by Dillon (Thanks, Dillon!)
 - Nominee for Secretary: Don Harris generously volunteers to serve (Thanks, Don!)
- MCREST Bottle Drive: Bottle returns open up across Michigan on June 15th; coordination will take place with Christian Service; question about bottle storage; Don hopes to coordinate with local stores to help expedite the process
- **Coffee and Donuts:** Julie is going to type up notes on how to organize/host coffee & donuts to send to Pat and is willing to come in and help whoever it takes over when it is reinstated (may be later in the fall)

Round Table-some confusion during 11:30 mass about the logistics of communion (which way to walk once communion is received)-further communication with parishioners is encouraged; donations to parish library are welcome (talk to Deacon); thank you to Meghan for chairing Parish Council
